- Take **Interstate 90** to Big Timber (Exits 367 or 370)
- Follow **Hwy 10** (from the East) or **Hwy 191** (from the West) to downtown Big Timber
- Turn South on **McLeod Street** (this becomes Hwy 298)
- Clydehurst is 35 miles from Big Timber.

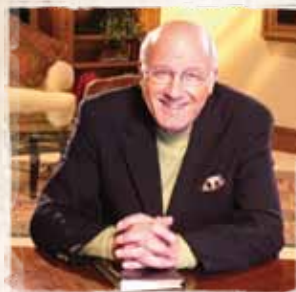

Preston and his wife, Christine, have four kids (three girls and a boy).

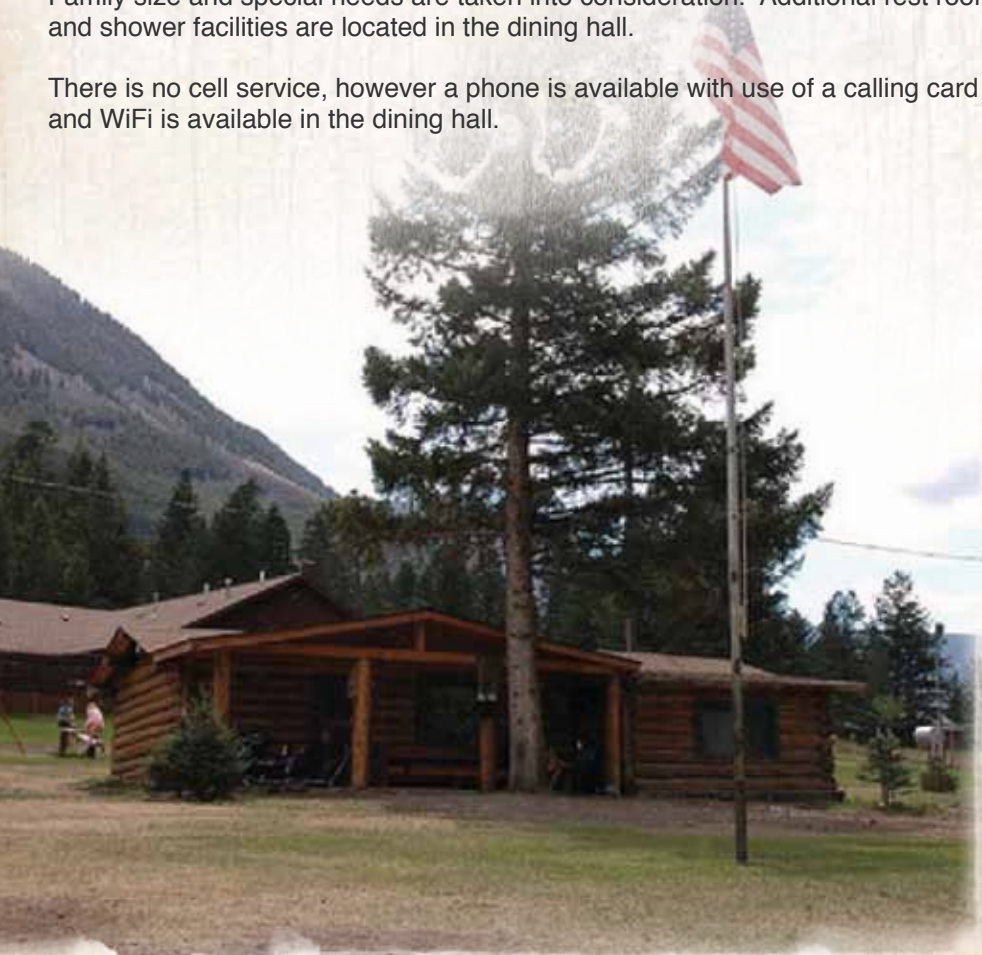
ACCOMMODATIONS

Real log cabins and buildings contribute to Clydehurst's rustic charm and include a centrally located lodge with pool tables, air hockey, and ping pong tables. The Lodge also houses Clydehurst Outfitters (shirt shop), the Hunger Hut (snack shop), and our very own coffee shop called The Front Porch.

A cozy chapel with the river nearby provides an amazing atmosphere for spiritual growth. Our modern kitchen and dining hall provides three meals daily including sack lunches by request for hikes and family outings. The camp laundry provides coin-operated machines for your convenience.

Each cabin is equipped with a queen sized bed and a set of single bunks (more can be added if needed). Bedding is not provided. All cabins have hot and cold running water as well as bathing and toilet facilities under the same roof. Many have private baths, though some are duplexes and have shared baths. Cabins are determined first by postmark, with requests honored as much as possible. Family size and special needs are taken into consideration. Additional rest room and shower facilities are located in the dining hall.

There is no cell service, however a phone is available with use of a calling card and WiFi is available in the dining hall.



REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Register for any camp by completing the attached form (or download a form from our website, www.clydehurst.com). A deposit of \$250 (check or money order in U.S. funds) should be enclosed with the registration form. Please use one form per family. We only accept registration forms via mail (do not FedEx, UPS, or overnight registrations) postmarked **no sooner than January 2nd**. Any registration with a postmark prior to this date will be returned. Since space is limited, registration forms along with the deposit are accepted on a first-come, first serve basis, by earliest postmark.

Registration can also be completed online at www.clydehurst.com (Credit card fees apply). Online registration will officially open at 9 am MST on January 2nd. Online registrations do not guarantee reservations. The date of online submissions will carry the same weight as postmarked registrations.

Camp registration starts no earlier than 3:00 pm and ends at 5:00 pm on Sunday. Camp officially begins with the evening meal at 5:30 pm and ends with breakfast on the following Saturday.

RETREATS

In the off-season, Clydehurst opens its doors to groups for purposes of family reunions, retreats, and conferences. The weather may be changing but the scenery is still picture perfect. If you're looking for that great place to get away with a group without the distractions of the everyday grind, then this is the place for you.

ACCOMMODATIONS

The facilities at Clydehurst include a dining hall where meals are served and where most groups choose to hold their meetings. If weather still permits, you can make use of the chapel for your meetings. The lodge is a great place to relax or partake in games like pool, ping-pong, and air hockey. The cabins are rustic with wood stoves for heating. Some cabins are ideal for small groups or we can accommodate large groups in our all-weather 5-plex. Rifle Range, Archery, Campfire, Hiking & Fishing, Hayrides, Basketball, Horseshoes, Volley Ball, Game Room and Frisbee Golf are also available.
